Our beans are sourced from Jumping Bean in St John's and are entirely fairly traded, and organic where possible. We are proud to support Jumping Bean's initiative to use the EcO, roasting system, which reduces CO<sub>2</sub> by 85%. All our coffees are made from freshly ground beans and whole milk. If you prefer 2%, low fat, soya or almond milk please ask.

#### House Mugs

Our 'House Mug' option is our way of giving a little bit back. We buy our mugs from a Thrift shop, or they are donated to us, and we give them a new life serving coffee to you. Each time you use a 'House Mug' we donate 5c to charity. Last year it was a local charity *Feral Felines* to support their work with stray cats.
